



Dark Colour Disclaimer Warning

Within the many brands of Solid Surface that we offer, there are a number of very dark and very solid colours. Care should be taken when considering using these colours, as they are not recommended for use within kitchens or areas of high usage, as they will require higher maintenance in order to keep their appearance. Scratches will appear white due to the higher pigmentation used to obtain the strong, dense colours.

No brand of Solid Surface is indestructible, they are very resilient with high resistance. They will, however, scratch when scored. Use of a chopping board is essential when chopping. Solid Surfaces will burn if excess heat is applied and in extreme cases will crack. Use of trivets or hot rods will help avoid such problems as these. All damage can be rectified, but will only be covered by Warranty if the surfaces have been treated with care according to our guidelines and the guidelines of the manufacturer.

BSF Solid Surfaces Ltd will always stand by the workmanship of the surfaces we supply, but will not, however, accept any responsibility for such problems as scratching, burning, cracking etc that have occurred as a result of misuse. Additionally, we will not take responsibility for dissatisfaction due to the choice of colour, in particular the darker and higher pigmented colours, which will show scratches, stains and signs of usage more than the lighter colours and those with larger particulates.

Colours to avoid: Any dense colours, or colours with no particulates will be higher maintenance. The very dark or highly pigmented colours will require more care as they will also scratch white due to the composition. Some colours may not be mentioned here, please check prior to progressing forward.

Colours with veining or directional patterns such as the Petals range of Avonite should be avoided in areas where seaming is required as the nature of the pattern will highlight the seams.

Colours with Mica will show directionality more than other colours. Please be advised that seams in Solid Surface are inconspicuous, **NOT INVISIBLE**, there is, therefore, a possibility that seams may be detectable to the naked eye when certain colours are specified.
